Plast is national, scouting organization in Ukraine. It is nonpartisan undenominational youth organization. The main goal of the organization is to foster comprehensive patriotic development and self-development of Ukrainian youth in order to turn them into conscious, responsible and good citizens of local, national and world community and to make them conductors of the society, using ideological grounds of Plast and Christian moral.

Plast is the biggest Ukrainian youth organization. 137 offices of Plast work in 23 regions of Ukraine. Plast unites more than 8000 people of different age starting from the youngest 2-year-old children to senior Plast members, who help to conduct training activity. Plast as an analogue of the scouting movement appeared in Ukraine in 1911. On April 12, 1912 students of the first founders of Plast, Oleksandr Tysovskyi, gave their oaths. Amongst the founders of Plast were: Oleksandr Tysovskyi, Petro Franko and Ivan Chmola.

Plast is using scouting methods in educating children. It also holds multiple summer camps including international every year. Each camp has its own specialization: avionic, maritime, military, sport, traveling, teaching and educative and others. Besides summer camps, Plast organizes different events and actions, for example sports competitions, sports and athletic meetings, hiking contest, festivals of Plast art, International scouting event "Peace Light of Bethlehem", art and intellectual competitions etc.



Amongst the most famous Plast alumni are Hollywood actress Katheryn Winnick, worldwide known economist Bohdan Havrylyshyn, and famous scientist and HDD inventor Lyubomy Romankiv (IBM). Plast members were active participants of Revolution of Dignity in 2014 and now protect Ukraine during Ukrainian-Russian war. Five Plast members died during warfare on the East of the country.

By 2030 Plast should become a sustainable organization, available to every child that does positive changes on local and national levels

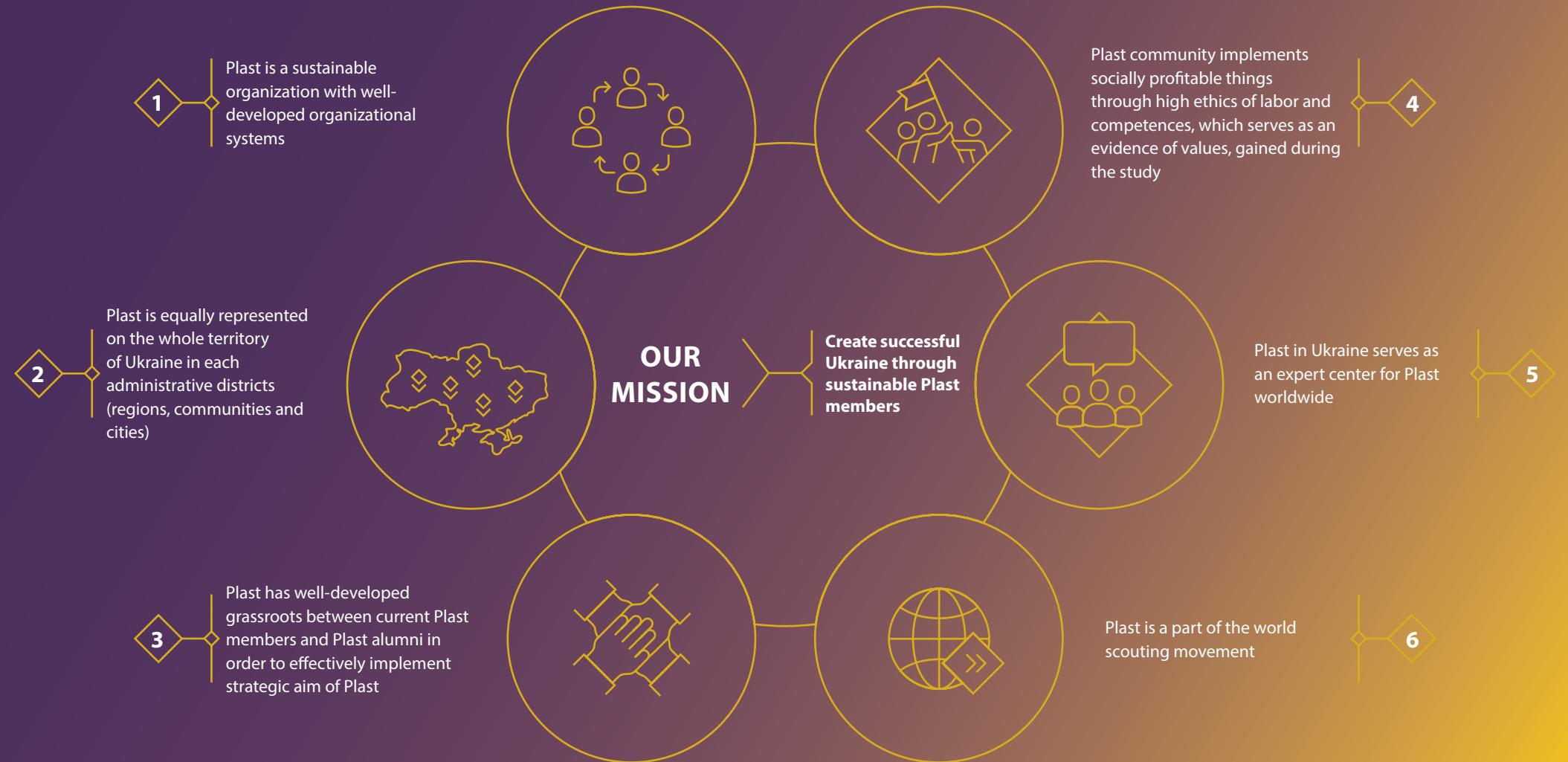
The Strategy is based on Plast values:

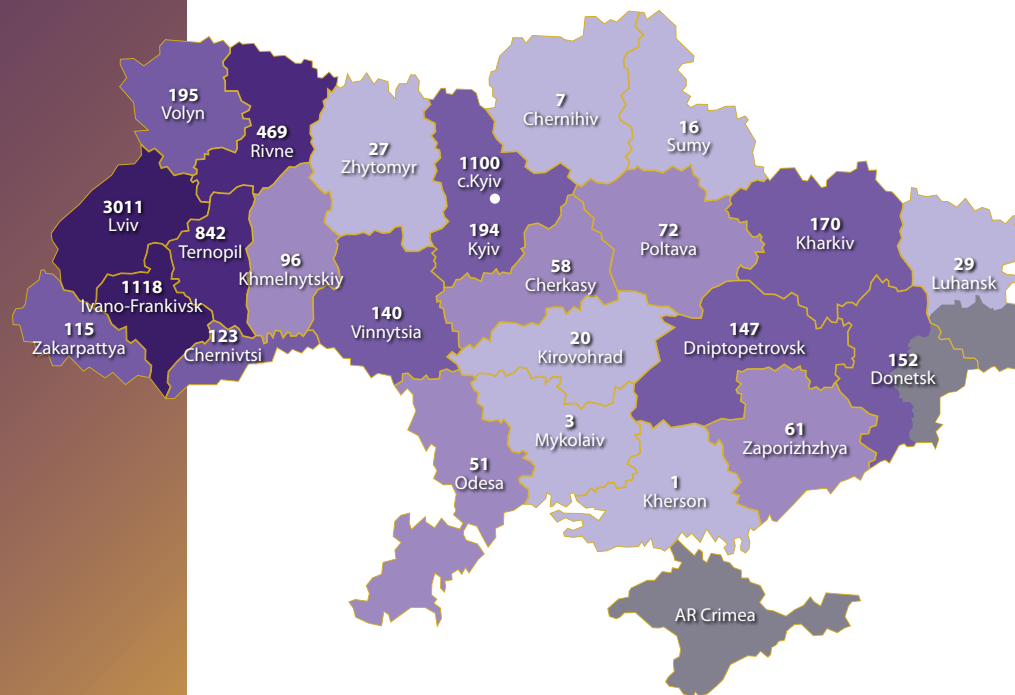
